Our Hospitality School have selected their favourite meal and dessert that would be great for Valentine's Day, show that special someone how you feel with one of these recipes.

mediterranean parsnip gnocchi

Ingredients

400g Parsnip, peeled and cut into chunks 600g Potatoes, peeled and cut into chunks 60ml Olive oil 3 Unpeeled garlic cloves I tsp Ground nutmeg 100g '00' flour (GF if required with I teaspoon of xanthan gum) 2 tbsp. nutritional yeast

I50g mixed peppers, cut approx.1½ inch pieces I50g Aubergine, cut into approx.1½ inch diameter slices I50g cherry tomatoes I tsp dried basil

> Sprinkling of chopped walnuts Grated Italian cheese to serve

Method

I.Heat the oven to 220c/200fan/gas mark7

2.Toss the prepared parsnips and potatoes in 2 tbsp. of olive oil and tip into a roasting tin along with the unpeeled garlic cloves

3.Place in the oven and roast for approx. 40 minutes or until the veg is completely soft

4.Remove from the oven using an oven cloth and allow to cool a little

5.Squeeze the garlic from their skins, then discard the skins

6.Tip everything into a food processor along with the nutmeg, flour and nutritional yeast. Season well then place the lid on

7.Pulse the processor until well combined and holding together as a dough

8.Meanwhile place the prepared peppers, aubergine and cherry tomatoes on a baking tray that is sprayed with frylight. Spray the frylight on top of the vegetables also and sprinkle with the dried basil and some cracked black pepper

9.Place in the oven and cook for approx. 15 minutes, or until the vegetables are charred and roasted. 10.Put a large pan of salted water onto a high heat on the hob and bring to the boil.

II.Tip the dough from the processor onto a floured surface

I2.Cut into 4 chunks.

13.Roll each chunk into a sausage about 35cm long and 2.5cm wide

I4.Use a butter knife to cut each sausage into small pillow shaped gnocchi, each around 2cm long

15.Gently press each of the pillow shaped gnocchi onto the back of a fork to create indentations

I6.Once all the gnocchi has been prepared, cook in the boiling salted water in batches (so as not to overcrowd the pan)for I minute or until they float to the surface

I7.Remove from the water with a slotted spoon and drain on kitchen paper

18.In a frying pan heat the rest of the olive oil and batch fry the gnocchi until lightly golden on each side.

19.Transfer them to a tray using a slotted spoon while you're cooking each batch

20.When all the gnocchi is golden put the tray in the oven to warm back through with the roasted vegetables combined

21.Once warm, remove from the oven and serve with grated Italian cheese and a sprinkling of walnuts



valentines bakewell tart



Ingredients

Shortcrust Pastry


225g Plain flour 100g Butter, diced Pinch of salt

Frangipane

350g Ground almonds 250g Unsalted butter 300g Caster sugar 3 Large eggs

Additional Ingredients Needed

3 Tps strawberry or raspberry jam I Handful flaked almonds



Method

Shortcrust pastry : I.Sift the flour into a large bowl (if gluten free sift the flour together with the Xanthan gum)

2.Add the salt and butter and rub in with fingertips until the mixture resembles fine breadcrumbs

3.Add 2-3 tablespoons of water and mix to a firm dough. (if Gluten free add egg instead of water)

4.Wrap in cling film and chill while preparing the filling.

Frangipane:

I.Beat the butter and sugar together until light and creamy.

2.Add the ground almonds and mix together.

3.Lightly beat the eggs and add to the mixture. Fold the eggs into the mixture until completely smooth and mixed together.

4.Place in the fridge until ready to use.

Bakewell Tart

I.Preheat an oven to I80 c / I60 fan

2.Line a 28cm loose bottomed tart tin with the shortcrust pastry by rolling it out slightly bigger than needed and covering the base and sides of the tin with the pastry and allowing it to hang over the tin but pushing it tightly in to fit against the sides. Prick the base with a fork.

3.Bake in the oven for 15 minutes lined with greaseproof paper and baking beans

4.Remove from the oven and reduce the temperature to 170 c / 150 fan 5.Spread the jam over the base of the pastry case.

6. Spoon the frangipane mixture evenly on top of the jam.

7.Sprinkle some flaked almonds on top of the frangipane

8.Bake the tart in the oven for approx. 40 minutes or until the almond mixture has become firm and golden on the outside but is still soft in the middle. Allow to cool for about 30 minutes before slicing.


