







# little duck finger puppet

#### **Instructions**

- Draw a duck or copy from picture onto cardboard
- Colour the duck on both sides draw eyes, bill and circle to cut hole for your finger
- Make sure an adult helps you to cut out your duck and cut a hole as in the picture
- Place your finger into the puppet and use your voice to say "Quack Quack "Make your puppet move and swim!

## recipes

ginger bread biscuits method page - 13



Ingredients

75g butter
3 I/2tbsp golden syrup
60g light soft brown sugar
I75g plain flour
I/4 tsp bicarbonate of soda
2tsp ground ginger

puff pastry pizzas method page - 14



Ingredients

320g ready-rolled light
puff pastry
6 tbsp tomato purée
I tbsp tomato ketchup
I tsp dried oregano
75g mozzarella or cheddar

#### For the topping

sweetcorn, olives, peppers, red onion, cherry tomatoes, spinach, basil

## ginger bread people

#### Method

- Add butter, golden syrup and light brown sugar to a pan.
   Stir on a low heat until sugar has dissolved.
- 2. Add flour, bicarbonate of soda and ginger to a mixing bowl then stir together. Make a well in the centre and pour in the sugar and butter mixture.
- 3. Stir together to form a dough (it might be easiest to use your hands).
- 4. Wrap in clingfilm and let chill for 30mins to firm up.
- Lay the dough between two sheets of baking parchment.
   Press dough lightly with a rolling pin. Give a quarter turn than repeat.
- 6. Give it a final quarter turn, then start to roll backwards and forwards, giving regular quarter turns. Until dough is roughly thickness of a £I coin.
- 7. Using a biscuit cutter cut out the shapes. Bake at 190°C (170°C fan) mark 5 for 10 to 12min, until lightly golden brown.
- 8. The biscuits won't be firm but will harden when left to cool outside the oven.

## puff pastry pizzas

#### Method

- I. Heat the oven to 200C/I80C fan/gas 6. Unroll the pastry, cut into six squares and arrange over two baking trays lined with baking parchment. Use a cutlery knife to score a Icm border around the edge of each pastry square. Bake for I5 mins, until puffed up but not cooked through.
- While the pastry cooks, make the sauce and prepare your toppings. Mix the tomato purée, tomato ketchup, oregano and I tbsp water. Grate the cheese and chop any veg or herbs you want to put on top into small pieces. Set aside.
- 3. Remove the pastry from the oven and squash down the middles with the back of a spoon. Divide the sauce between the pastry squares and spread it out to the puffed-up edges. Sprinkle with the cheese, then add your toppings. Bake for another 5-8 mins and serve.


