	<p>Our Privacy Notice explains what information we collect and why.</p> <p>The policy specifically explains how we, our partners, and users of our service use cookies, as well as the options you have to control them.</p>
	<p>What are cookies?</p> <p>Cookies are small pieces of data, stored in text files, that are stored on your computer or other device when websites are loaded in a browser. They are widely used to 'remember' you and your preferences, either for a single visit (through a 'session cookie') or for multiple visits (using a 'persistent visit').</p>
	<p>Why do we use cookies?</p> <p>We use cookies to help remember you each time you visit the website, so we can make sure you have a good experience.</p> <p>For example, we use cookies to help us remember what is in your shopping cart on our online shop. We also use these to tell us what pages people visited on the website and what pages they spend more time on so we can make the website better.</p>
	<p>Controlling cookies</p> <p>You may wish to restrict the use of cookies or completely stop them from being set. Most browsers provide ways to control cookie behaviour, such as the length of time they are stored – either through built-in functionality or by utilising third party plug ins.</p> <p>If you disable cookies, please be aware some features of our service may not work correctly.</p>

Google Analytics	HTTP Cookies	<p>These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site.</p> <p>The cookies collect information in an anonymous form (so we do not have names), including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.</p>
