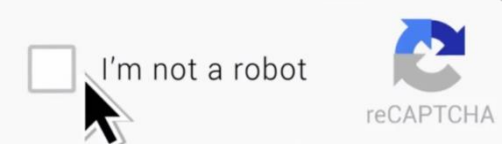





reCAPTCHA analyses

	<p>Our website uses a service called reCAPTCHA. This is a service provided by Google. On our website we use reCAPTCHA when someone uses the online enquiry form to ask us a question and when people make a donation to the charity.</p>
	<p>Why do we use Google reCAPTCHA? We use this service to make sure that it is a real person looking through the website, asking us a question, or trying to donate money. Some illegal people or companies try to use automated programmes known as 'bots' to send fake questions or donate money that does not belong to them.</p>
	<p>How does Google reCAPTCHA work? There are lots of ways to find out if a human is looking through the website, or if it is a 'bot'. Some ways Google can tell is by the speed in which the mouse moves across the website pages or how long someone has been on the website. Most of the time we do not know that this work by reCAPTCHA is happening as it takes place in the background. You may know it is being used when you try to send a question or donation because a box will appear saying 'I'm not a robot' and a human would tick this to be able to carry on.</p>
