I. A4 paper, bowl, glass, pencil



4. Crease this side too



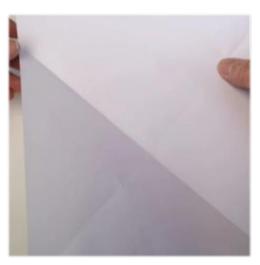
2. Fold paper diagonally to make a square and crease



5. Fold over the top to meet the diagonal lines



3. Fold the opposite side diagonally



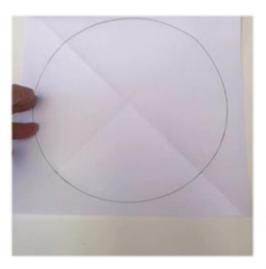
6. Now you have a square and the folds show the middle



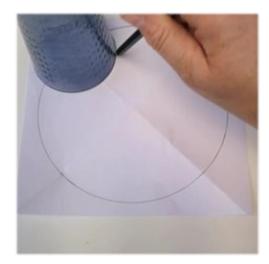
7. Place the bowl upside down in the centre of the paper



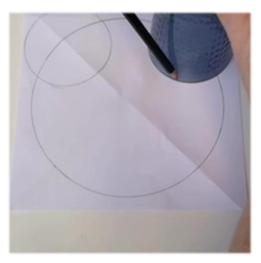
8. Draw around the bowl



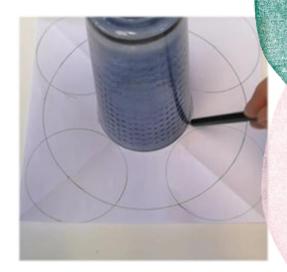
9. To make the centre circle



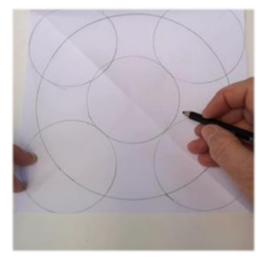
IO. Draw around the glass in the top left corner



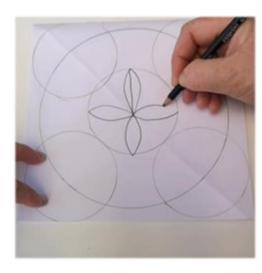
II. Then the top right, bottom left and bottom right



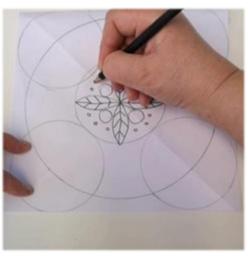
12. Put a circle in the centre if you want to



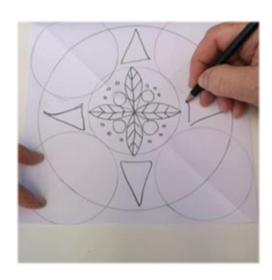
13. Now you have all your circles in place



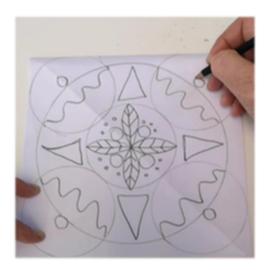
14. Start to add your details



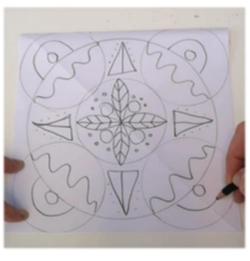
15. Fill the centre



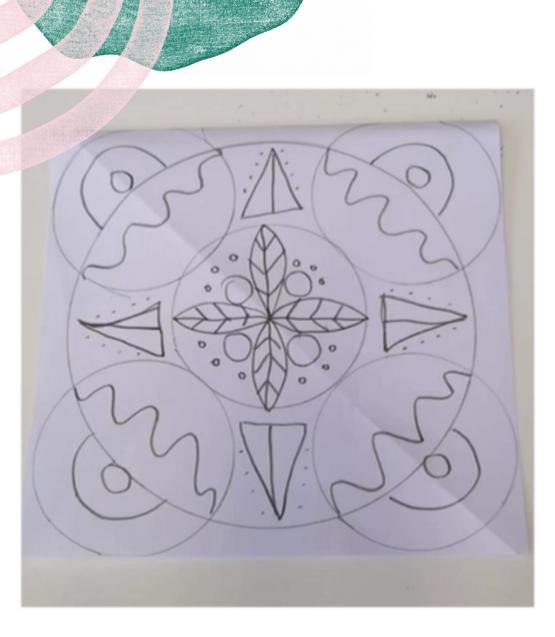
16. Work to the outside with other



17. Out to the edges shapes



18. Its up to you when you think you are finished



You can add as little or as much detail as you like to your mandala, it's your design.
