Brilliant Basics is the name of our plan for the year. The plan explains what we want to do and how we are going to do it.







We will continue to build strong relationships with people, like your family members. And they will be able to contribute to how we support you.


















We will be looking at all your homes, making sure they are right for you and your needs and wishes.
